


Sign in with Google

- Most convenient
- Just into any device with your Google account

Ledger Hardware Wallet

- Most secure
- Requires confirmation with device for every transaction


Create Recovery Phrase


- More secure
- Requires the recovery phrase to sign into additional devices or recover your account

Seed Phrase

Create 12 or 24 word recovery phrase

- More words, more secure
- This phrase gives access to your wallet






Safely store recovery phrase

- Without it, you will be unable to recover your wallet
- Write it out, put it in a safe, put it in a secure deposit box, etc.

Wallet created

Your public wallet addresses

- This is where you can find the receiving addresses of your wallet
- You have a different address for each blockchain, all connected to your recovery key
- Copy the address to the blockchain you wish to send assets to



- Or connect your wallet directly for ease of use



 Select the blockchain to get an overview



- Click Start Staking




Select Validator

Validators

Validators run the decentralised security infrastructure of the blockchain

- Choose a validator that has a good commission rate
- 5% is typically a good rate




Stake

Once you choose a validator, input the amount to stake

- Don't stake all of your funds.
- Always leave some funds available to pay for fees.

Claim your rewards

- Once you have started staking, you will immediately start collecting a return
- Periodically you can claim your rewards, and restake to compound your APR
